

# WATER CONSERVATION RESOLUTION

Resolution # 031007

WHEREAS, Town Council in the Town of Boiling Springs is concerned with water conservation;  
and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Boiling Springs intends to promote water conservation to its  
homeowners; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Boiling Springs intends to develop a water conservation incentive rate  
structure; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF  
BOILING SPRINGS, that the Town of Boiling Springs will give each homeowner connected to  
the Town of Boiling Springs Water System

Section 1. A one time \$10.00 credit on their water bill if a homeowner provides proof from a  
plumber of the complete installation of low-flow faucets in their home.

Section 2. A one time \$15.00 credit on their water bill if a homeowner provides proof from a  
plumber of the installation of a low-flow shower head in their home.

Section 3. A one time \$20.00 credit on their water bill if a homeowner provides proof from a  
plumber of the installation of a low-flow toilet in their home.

Section 4. There is a credit limit of \$100.00 per household.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town of Boiling Springs hereby commits to beginning a  
water conservation and education program consisting of water conservation educational items  
being placed on monthly water bills and other items to residents of the Town of Boiling Springs.
