

TOWN OF BOILING SPRINGS, N.C.

ENACTING AS AN ORDINANCE, A CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE TOWN OF BOILING SPRINGS REVISING, AMENDING, RESTATING, CODIFYING, AND COMPILING CERTAIN EXISTING GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN DEALING WITH SUBJECTS EMBRACED IN SAID CODE.

WHEREAS, the present general ordinances of the Town of Boiling Springs, N.C. are incomplete and inadequate and the manner of arrangement, classification and indexing thereof is insufficient to meet the immediate needs of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Acts of the General Assembly of the State of North Carolina empower and authorize the Town Board of Commissioners to revise, amend, restate, codify and to compile any existing ordinance or ordinances and all new ordinances not heretofore adopted or published and to incorporate said ordinances into one ordinance in book form; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Commissioners of the Town of Boiling Springs, N.C. has authorized a general compilation, revision and codification of the ordinances of the Town of a general and permanent nature and publication of such ordinances in book form.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of Commissioners of the Town of Boiling Springs, North Carolina that:

Section 1. The general ordinances of the Town of Boiling Springs, N.C. as herein revised, amended, restated, codified, and compiled in book form are adopted as and shall constitute the "Code of Ordinances of the Town of Boiling Springs, North Carolina".

Section 2. Said Code as adopted in Section 1 shall consist of the following titles to-wit:

Section 3. All prior ordinances pertaining to the subjects treated in said Code shall be deemed repealed from and after the effective date of said Code except as they are included and reordained in whole or in part in said Code; provided such repeal shall not affect any offense committed or penalty incurred or any right established prior to the effective date of said Code, nor shall such repeal affect the provisions of ordinances levying taxes, appropriating money, annexing or detaching territory, establishing franchises or granting special rights to certain persons, authorizing public improvements, authorizing the issuance of bonds or the borrowing of money, authorizing the purchase or sale of real or personal property, granting or accepting easements, plat or dedication of land to public use, naming or vacating or setting the boundaries of streets, alleys or other public places, nor to any other ordinance of a temporary or special nature or pertaining to subjects not contained herein.

Boiling Springs - Adopting Ordinance

Section 4. Said Code shall be deemed published as of the day of its adoption and approval by the Town Board of Commissioners and the Town Clerk of the Town of Boiling Springs, N.C. is hereby authorized and ordered to file a copy of said Code in the Office of the Town Clerk.

Section 5. Said Code shall be in force and effect immediately upon its adoption by the Town Board of Commissioners and filing in the Office of the Town Clerk, and said Code shall be presumptive evidence in all courts and places of the ordinance and all provisions, sections, penalties and regulations therein contained as of the date of passage, and that the same is properly signed, attested, recorded and approved.

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING AND ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF BOILING SPRINGS, NORTH CAROLINA.

WHEREAS, the Town of Boiling Springs has contracted with American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio to annually supplement the Code and said corporation has completed the 1994 S-1 Supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Boiling Springs, N.C., which supplement contains all ordinances of a general nature enacted since the adoption of the Code or previously enacted and were not included in the original Code of Ordinances of the Town of Boiling Springs, N.C.; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Boiling Springs has adopted new or amended ordinances and said American Legal Publishing Corporation has completed the revision or addition of certain sections of the Code of Ordinances which are based on or make references to sections of the Code and the N.C. General Statutes; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Town Board of Commissioners to accept these updated sections in accordance with the changes of North Carolina General Statutes and the Code of Ordinances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of Commissioners of the Town of Boiling Springs, North Carolina:

Section 1. That the 1994 S-1 Supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Boiling Springs, North Carolina as submitted by American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio is hereby adopted by reference as if set out in its entirety.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its date of passage.

ENACTING AND ADOPTING ORDINANCE - 1995 S-2 SUPPLEMENT

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING AND ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF BOILING SPRINGS, NORTH CAROLINA.

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio has completed the 1995 S-2 Supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Boiling Springs, which supplement contains all ordinances of a general nature enacted since their prior supplement to the Code of Ordinances of this municipality; and

WHEREAS, said American Legal Publishing Corporation has recommended the revision or addition of certain sections of the Code of Ordinances which are based on or make references to sections of the the North Carolina Code; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Council to accept these updated sections in accordance with the changes of the laws of the State of North Carolina;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Boiling Springs, State of North Carolina:

SECTION 1. That the 1995 S-2 Supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Boiling Springs, North Carolina as submitted by American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, and attached hereto, be and the same is hereby adopted by reference as if set out in its entirety.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its date of passage.
