CHAPTER 130: OFFENSES AGAINST TOWN REGULATIONS

• **130.01 DISCHARGE OF WEAPONS OR OTHER EXPLOSIVES PROHIBITED; EXCEPTION.**

It shall be unlawful for any person to shoot or explode any gun, pistol or other explosive of whatever character or air rifle or other similar weapons in the town, on the streets, alleys, on any church grounds, school property, or college property, or town property, or in the business section, or any residential section of the town. This subchapter shall not apply to the use of weapons by law enforcement officers, night watchmen, or any person using a weapon in the lawful defense of his home, person, family, or property.

• **130.02 OBSTRUCTION OF RIGHT-OF-WAYS.**

It shall be unlawful to congregate on the street and sidewalks of the town of Boiling Springs, so as to block or hinder pedestrians or traffic in the use of the streets, and to refuse to move on, or to disperse when instructed to do so by an officer of the law.

• **130.03 POSTING SIGNS PROHIBITING HANDGUNS ON TOWN PROPERTY.**

(A) Posting of Signs Required. The Chief of Police is hereby ordered to post appropriate signage on each park, building or portion of a building now or hereafter owned, leased as lessee, operated, occupied, managed or controlled by the town, as well as the appurtenant premises to such buildings, indicating that concealed handguns are prohibited therein.

(B) Location of Signs. The signs shall be visible posted on the exterior of each entrance by which the general public can access the building, appurtenant premise, or park. The Chief of Police shall exercise discretion in determining the necessity and appropriate location for other signs posted on the interior of any building, appurtenant premise, or park.

(C) Exemptions. This section shall not apply to municipal streets or public state roads located within the town; nor shall this section be construed so as to limit the right of any lessee of a Public Housing Authority unit to carry a concealed handgun within such unit.

• 130.99 PENALTY.

(A) (1) Any violation of any provision of this chapter shall subject the violator to a civil penalty in the sum of \$50 per day.

(a) A citation of said civil penalty shall be issued by the Code Enforcement Officer.

(b) Each citation for a civil penalty must be paid within 48 hours of issuance.

(B) The municipality may also, and in addition, seek any and all appropriate equitable remedies, injunctions and/or abatement orders from the appropriate court of competent jurisdiction.
