

TOWN OF BOILING SPRINGS
ORDINANCE AMENDING TOWN CHARTER
ORDINANCE #030304

WHEREAS, the Town Charter of the Town of Boiling Springs does not provide specifically for the operation of the governing body of the Town under either of the alternative forms of government which are provided by the terms of North Carolina General Statutes §160A-101(9); and

WHEREAS, the Town of Boiling Springs has for many years and presently operates under a modified form of the Mayor-Manager form of government provided for by the said statutory authority; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Boiling Springs now wishes to amend its Charter to provide that the Town of Boiling Springs will hereafter operate and be governed under that Council-Manager form of government as provided by the terms of North Carolina General Statutes §160A-101(9);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Boiling Springs that the Charter of the Town of Boiling Springs is hereby amended by the addition of a new section after Section 14 of the current Charter, such new section to be known and designated as Section 14.1 and entitled "Form of Government".

The text of the new Section 14.1 shall be as follows:

Pursuant to the provisions of §160A-101(9) of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the Town of Boiling Springs hereby adopts and will conduct the operations of its municipal government under the "Council-Manager" form of government as described and provided in Chapter 7 Part 2 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes of North Carolina.

Within ten (10) days after the effective date of this Ordinance, a Notice shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipal limits stating that an Ordinance amending the Town Charter of Boiling Springs has been adopted and summarizing in such Notice the contents and effect of such amendment.

The Town Clerk shall file a certified copy of this Ordinance amending the Town's Charter with the Secretary of State of North Carolina and the North Carolina legislative library.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption.

ADOPTED at a regular meeting of the Boiling Springs Town Council by a unanimous vote of a quorum of the Town Council Members present at such meeting.
