City of Shelby and the Town of Boiling Springs Remove Voluntary Water Conservation Measures

The City of Shelby and the Town of Boiling Springs announce the lifting of Voluntary Water Conservation Measures as a result of the recent rain events in the First Broad River watershed drainage area. The removal of voluntary restrictions is in accordance with the Code of Ordinances and Water Shortage Response Plan, where river flows have exceeded the criteria established for voluntary conservation measure implementation.

We appreciate your cooperation and response to the voluntary water restrictions. We will continue to keep water customers up to date with any change in the official drought status. We ask our customers to continue to use water responsibly, by repairing leaks and following other standard water conservation measures.
